• Actively promotes a strong safety culture through continuous review of procedures and guidance, proactive involvement in safety meetings, job planning, and risk assessments.

#### **Technical and Supervision**

- Provides engineering expertise for electrical infrastructure maintenance, design, construction, upgrades and modifications to the existing network.
- Ensures the integrity of the electrical rail network is maintained at a safety level that protects the PTA's maintenance crews, contractors and the public at railway stations and along the rail reserve.
- Validates and approves the testing and commissioning of project works associated with electrical infrastructure.
- Plans and prioritises maintenance, repairs and construction activities daily and consistent with ongoing demands.
- Acts as custodian of electrical infrastructure drawings and documents to 'as built', 'upgrade' and 'current' states.
- Audits and monitors the quality and standard of works undertaken by contractors, and reports on outcomes.

#### **Project/Contract Management**

- Manages high value and high risk projects, coordinates and plans in house teams and/or contractors undertaking design and/or construction of railway electrical infrastructure.
- Monitors and directs for compliance to approved specifications, budgets, time and quality.
- Prepares technical specifications and tender documents for electrical infrastructure work.

#### Liaison & Customer Service

- Liaises with functional and operational areas within the PTA and other relevant government agencies as required to achieve optimum OHWE and train service operations.
- Liaises with contractors employed on behalf of the PTA.

### **Training & Development**

• In consultation with the Workplace Trainer & Assessor (Electrical), identifies appropriate training & development programs to ensure that the maintenance teams are given the required knowledge to be competent in carrying out their maintenance activities.

#### **Other Duties**

• Represents the Branch at meetings as required including other duties as directed.

#### **Essential Work Related Requirements**

#### 1. Job Specific

- Possession of a Degree in Engineering (Electrical) to allow eligibility for membership to the Institute of Engineers (Australia) in the category of Chartered Professional Engineer.
- Demonstrated extensive and recent experience in the design/maintenance of 25kVac Overhead Wiring Equipment and/or 25kVac Traction Power systems
- Proven knowledge of rail safety management.
- Experience in project management and contract management.

#### 2. Management & Leadership

• Demonstrated experience in managing the performance of an operational team and financial/physical resources in the achievement of agreed outcomes and provide a customer focussed service.

#### 3. Communication and Interpersonal
