Our Graduate Program has been recognised Australia wide and is a joint initiative between the Department of State Development, the Department of Mines and Petroleum, and the Department of Regional Development. The Graduate Program is a structured 18 month program which combines targeted and comprehensive training (both formal and on the job) with three-month placements throughout the participating departments, and potentially other government departments. Initial employment is on an 18 month contract with provision for permanent appointment following the successful completion of the first 12 months.

As part of the Workforce and Diversity Plan, university graduates up to 25 years of age, people with a disability, and people of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander descent are encouraged to apply. To be eligible you must be an Australian Citizen, permanent resident or hold an appropriate work visa.
