Prime Function / Key Responsibilities

Provides assessment and treatment interventions relating to Occupational Therapy within a designated caseload.

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Brief Summary of Duties (in order of importance)

1. Clinical

- 1.1 Screens clients for Occupational Therapy input.
- 1.2 Conducts appropriate assessments with regards to client performance components (physical, cognitive, perceptual, sensory, social, psychological and behavioural).
- 1.3 Plans and conducts individual and group interventions as required.
- 1.4 Evaluates effectiveness of treatment/ intervention.
- 1.5 Documents client assessment, intervention and evaluation as per health service and departmental guidelines.

2. Administrative

- 2.1 Maintains accurate clinical and statistical records within designated area.
- 2.2 Attends and actively contributes to Occupational Therapy meetings.
- 2.3 Completes delegated administrative duties within agreed time frames.
- 2.4 Conducts activities in compliance with the Public Sector Management Act, Public Sector Code of Ethics, NMHS Code of Conduct and all Health Service policies and guidelines.

3. Research

- 3.1 Identifies areas of clinical practice that promote effective and efficient use of resources.
- 3.2 Undertakes/ assists with research projects using evidence based practice as directed by supervisor.

4. NMHS Governance, Safety and Quality Requirements

- 4.1 Participates in the maintenance of a safe work environment.
- 4.2 Participates in an annual performance development review.
- 4.3 Supports the delivery of safe patient care and the consumers' experience including participation in continuous quality improvement activities in accordance with the requirements of the National Safety and Quality Health Service Standards and other recognised health standards.
- 4.4 Completes mandatory training (including safety and quality training) as relevant to role.
- 4.5 Performs duties in accordance with Government, WA Health, North Metropolitan Health Service and Departmental / Program specific policies and procedures.
- 4.6 Abides by the WA Health Code of Conduct, Occupational Safety and Health legislation, the Disability Services Act and the Equal Opportunity Act.

- 6. Demonstrated ability to train and supervise Occupational Therapy students, Occupational Therapy Assistants and volunteers.
- 7. Current knowledge of legislative obligations for Equal Opportunity, Disability Services and Occupational Safety and Health, and how these impact on employment and service delivery
- 8. Current "C" or "C.A." class drivers licence.

Desirable Selection Criteria

- 1. Relevant experience in rehabilitation and aged care and general medicine.
- 2. Demonstrated interest in maintaining and upgrading professional skills through further education.
- 3. Demonstrated interest in evaluating Occupational Therapy programs through relevant research and quality improvement activities.
