Key Responsibilities: The Trainee will provide comprehensive coordinated outpatient and inpatient care to paediatric patients with or at risk of complicated infections. They will also provide clinical care in the paediatric tuberculosis and HIV services. They will act as a primary point of contact for clinical infectious diseases issues at PMH and will assist in the coordination and development of these services, particularly in the field of clinical audit and guideline development. They will have a major role in liaising with other relevant specialties and agencies. They will participate in educational activities and research.

Brief Summary of Duties (in order of importance)

1. Clinical

- 1.1 Inpatient infectious diseases consultations.
- 1.2 Inpatient management of infectious disease patients.
- 1.3 Antimicrobial stewardship and clinical infectious disease liaison rounds.
- 1.4 Paediatric infectious diseases, tuberculosis, immunisation and HIV clinics.
- 1.5 Participate in departmental and hospital meetings as required.
- 1.6 Participate in research and quality assurance activities.
- 1.7 Participate in postgraduate teaching of junior medical staff within the hospital.
- 1.8 Development of evidence-based guidelines and protocols in infectious diseases.
- 1.9 Perform other duties as required by paediatric infectious diseases physicians.
- 1.10 Participation in the hospital or departmental on call roster.

2. CAHS Governance, Safety and Quality requirements

- 2.1 Responsible for ensuring, as far as practicable, the provision of a safe working environment in consultation with staff under their supervision.
- 2.2 Performs duties in accordance with Government, WA Health, Child and Adolescent Health

2. Experience of clinical audit and guideline development.
3. Demonstrated commitment to clinical governance within health care.
4. Current knowledge of legislative obligations for Equal Opportunity, Disability Services and Occupational Safety and Health, and how these impact on employment and service delivery.
