1. Clinical

- 1.4 Is expected to be involved in the unit critical incident monitoring program and other audit activities as appropriate.
- 1.5 The registrar is a member of the Code Blue, Medical Emergency Team and Trauma Team.
- 1.6 Is expected to attend and actively participate in as many Hospital meetings and lectures etc. as possible.
