

Brief Summary of Duties (in order of importance)

1. Clinical

- 1.1 Expected to manage inpatients under the supervision of specialists in the Intensive Care Unit.
- 1.2 This post is accredited for CICM, FRACP, FACEM and FANZCA training. Staff will endeavour to support trainees in meeting the specific needs of their training program including formal projects and performance appraisal.
- 1.3 In the Paediatric Intensive Care Unit there will be exposure and involvement in the diagnosis and management of a variety of disorders and in the post-operative care of major surgical problems, including cardiac surgery.
- 1.4 Is expected to be involved in the unit critical incident monitoring program and other audit activities as appropriate.
- 1.5 The registrar is a member of the Code Blue, Medical Emergency Team and Trauma Team.
- 1.6 Is expected to attend and actively participate in as many Hospital meetings and lectures etc. as possible.

2. CAHS Governance, Safety and Quality requirements

- 2.1 Responsible for ensuring, as far as practicable, the provision of a safe working environment in consultation with staff under their supervision
- 2.2 Performs duties in accordance with Government, WA Health, Child and Adolescent Health
- 2.3 Service and Departmental/ Program Specific Policies and Procedures.
- 2.4 Performs duties in line with the National Safety and Quality Health Services Standards and within best practice.
- 2.5 Participates in a continual process to monitor, evaluate and improve patient safety and ensuring that services are family centred.
- 2.6 Performs duties in accordance with the relevant Occupational Safety and Health and Equal Opportunity Legislation and WA Health Code of Conduct.

3. Undertakes other duties as directed.

Work Related Requirements

Essential Selection Criteria

- 1. Eligible for registration by the Medical Board of Australia.
- Advanced trainee in paediatrics (RACP), intensive care (CICM), anaesthesia (ANZCA) or emergency medicine (ACEM).
- 3. Appropriate clinical experience in paediatrics, intensive care, anaesthesia or emergency medicine.
- 4. Demonstrated high level interpersonal and professional communication skills.
- 5. Proven ability to work effectively as a team member.
- 6. Commitment to continuing medical education.
- 7. Commitment to undergraduate and postgraduate medical teaching of residents, nursing staff and medical students.

Desirable Selection Criteria

- 1. Demonstrated interest in clinical research.
- 2. Current knowledge and commitment to Equal Opportunity in all aspects of employment and service delivery.

Appointment Prerequisites

Appointment is subject to:

- Evidence of registration by the Medical Board of Australia must be provided prior to commencement.
- Working With Children (WWC) Check, compulsory check for people who carry out childrelated work in Western Australia.
- Completion of 100 point identification check.
- Successful Criminal Record Screening Clearance.
- Successful Pre-Employment Integrity check.
- Successful Pre-Employment Health Assessment.
