

# **Brief Summary of Duties** (in order of importance)

### 1. Clinical

- 1.1 Provides care for inpatients in both ward and rehabilitation programs.
- 1.2 Provides care for patients referred to outpatient Paediatric Rehabilitation clinics.
- 1.3 Liaises with consultants, the liaison nurses, and allied health staff, junior medical and secretarial staff regarding paediatric rehabilitation patients.
- 1.4 Is committed to maintenance of professional standards.
- 1.5 Is committed to a team approach to patient care.
- 1.6 Participates in teaching of medical undergraduates and postgraduates.
- 1.7 Undertakes clinical research and or audit activities.
- 1.8 Develops and extends own professional skills and knowledge.
- 1.9 Participation in Department of Paediatric and Adolescent Medicine on call roster.

### 2. CAHS Governance, Safety and Quality requirements

- 2.1 Responsible for ensuring, as far as practicable, the provision of a safe working environment in consultation with staff under their supervision.
- 2.2 Performs duties in accordance with Government, WA Health, Child and Adolescent Health Service and Departmental/ Program Specific Policies and Procedures.
- 2.3 Performs duties in line with the National Safety and Quality Health Services Standards and within best practice.

# **Work Related Requirements**

### **Essential Selection Criteria**

- 1. Eligible for registration by the Medical Board of Australia.
- 2. Enrolled in FRACP or AFRM training.
- 3. Experience in teaching undergraduate and postgraduate.
- 4. Ability to work within a multidisciplinary team.
- 5. Is aware of own limitations and shows commitment to continuous improvement of patient outcomes.

### **Desirable Selection Criteria**

- 1 Shows a personal commitment to continuing medical education.
- 2 Monitors and reviews own clinical effectiveness.
- 3 Demonstrated commitment to clinical governance within health care.
- 4 Current knowledge of legislative obligations for Equal Opportunity, Disability Services and Occupational Safety and Health, and how these impact on employment and service delivery.

### Appointment Prerequisites

Appointment is subject to:

- Evidence of registration by the Medical Board of Australia must be provided prior to commencement.
- Working With Children (WWC) Check, compulsory check for people who carry out childrelated work in Western Australia.
- Completion of 100 point identification check.
- Successful Criminal Record Screening Clearance.
- Successful Pre-Employment Integrity check.
- Successful Pre-Employment Health Assessment.
