Key Responsibilities

Manages Adolescent and Young Adult Medicine inpatients and outpatients and participates in the Adolescent and Young Adult Medicine Training Program.

Brief Summary of Duties

1. Clinical

- Weekly Eating Disorder Outpatient Clinic.
- Participation in roster for medical assessments of new Eating Disorder assessments.
- Participation of inpatient care of Eating Disorder Patients, including bi-weekly multidisciplinary team ward rounds.
- · Assessment of consults from other teams within PMH.
- Coordination of the 'Prehab' program for young people with complex, chronic illness.
- Supervision and training of junior medical staff.
- Medical student teaching.
- Chairing and coordination of regular meetings held by the Adolescent Health Team.
- Option to act as on-call consultant (under supervision) for general medical admissions.
- One full day dedicated to research.
- Training in community placements (e.g. sexual health, mental health, drug and alcohol services) in the second year.

2. CAHS Governance, Safety and Quality Requirements

- 7. Current knowledge of legislative obligations for Equal Opportunity, Disability Services and Occupational Safety and Health, and how these impact on employment and service delivery.
