- Is respectful of all staff, patients and families through courteous interactions and promoting partnership in care.
- Is responsible in collaboration with the Registered Nurse for own learning and professional development through ongoing education and performance review.
- Participates in research, practice development, quality improvement and Accreditation processes to develop and demonstrate excellence in practice and patient outcomes.
- Participates in emergency management practices to ensure familiarity with policy and procedure.
