Divisional Outcomes

The Operational Services Division is responsible for professional development, health, intelligence, security and investigation services functions for the Department. All these elements have a direct impact on the provision of corrective services provided by the Department and the role has considerable influence on the delivery of integrated and optimised operational services, and support improved offender care and risk management across the Department.

Directorate Outputs

The Directorates role is to work in partnership with Adult and Juvenile Custodial Services to provide a comprehensive range of health care services to patients in custody, at a standard comparable to that available in the general community.

This is achieved through assessing health determinants, delivering preventative health care, health screening, delivering acute care within a primary care context and assessing the effectiveness of health care delivery.

The majority of health care provided to patients in custody is based on a primary health care model and predominantly relates to the management of Chronic Disease, Communicable Disease, Co-morbidity (Alcohol and Drug Addiction Services and Mental Health Services) and Acute Care response as required. The Directorate is also responsible for establishing and maintaining policy and standards.

Role of the Position

The position provides nursing care and management of patients in custody at both Pardelup Prison Farm and Albany Regional Prison.

All Nursing staff practice is in accordance with Australian Nursing and Midwifery Council (ANMC) National Competency Standards.

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Responsibilities of this Position

PATIENT CARE

- Provides competent nursing care to patients within a custodial context. This incorporates assessment, planning
 -implementation and evaluation of nursing interventions across the continuum of care
- Responds to medical emergencies arranging timely interventions within the facility and transfer to tertiary care.
- Facilitates patient health education and health promotion in a culturally appropriate manner.
- Promotes and coordinates the Key Responsibility Areas of Infectious Disease or Chronic Disease management as allocated.
- Provides opportunities for and encourages patients to be involved in their own health management
- Provides appropriate risk management for patients identified at risk of self harm
- Facilitates effective communication with patients, all levels of staff, and community health providers.
- Monitors and reviews standards of care within the unit to optimise patient outcomes
- Adheres to relevant professional health services and prison management policy requirements

SECURITY

- Maintains personal security by adhering to custodial policies and procedures
- Performs nursing duties adhering to the security requirements of the custodial environment.

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- Accountable for maintaining relevant skills and competence.
- Acts as a resource to others.
- Development of competencies through mentoring and coaching.

QUALITY IMPROVEMENT

- Identifies and develops unit based quality improvement activities within the framework of the quality cycle.
- Accountable for the safe, efficient and effective use of human and material resources
- Participates in risk management processes as required.



Planning, coordinating and evaluating the delivery of care to patients. Recognising patient needs, making decisions and solving problems regarding patient care.	
3. Quality and Risk Management Skills	Overseeing and managing the quality of patient care and ongoing quality improvement activities. Managing risk within the practice. Contributing to the development and evaluation of nursing policies and procedures. Undertaking the review, development and implementation of nursing procedures relevant to the health centre.	
4. Leadership & Teamwork Skills	Contributes as a member of the Clinical team. Provides team leadership and demonstrates commitment to continuous performance development of self and others.	
5. Communication and Interpersonal Skills	Providing clear and concise patient records and reports. Communicating effectively with a wide range of cultures, groups and individuals. Developing and maintaining professional workplace relationships. Facilitating multidisciplinary collaboration.
