Business Area Overview

Location Services provides trusted location data and spatial services to support the management and development of Western Australia to benefit the community. Data Collaboration ensures reliable data platforms to enable efficient sharing of location information, and the quality and timely provision of data sharing and collaboration programs.

Role Summary

The Lead Data Analyst provides expert advice and applies significant expertise to deliver Location Services functions which will include:

- Providing secure and stable platforms to enable the discoverability, access and sharing of public sector location data.
- Publishing data on behalf of public sector data custodians into collaboration platforms.
- Supporting customers and stakeholders with data requests and queries.
- Platform incident management and support through the IT service provider.
- Stakeholder engagement to promote the use of collaborative online data platforms.

Responsibilities

- Develops and maintains strategic partnerships across Landgate to facilitate service delivery.
- Proactively identifies opportunities for innovation and improvement and works with stakeholders across the business to implement these.
- Participates in internal and external committees and working groups, acting a representative for the business area.
- Mentors, coaches and develops staff in technical roles and provides leadership that encourages continuous learning.
- Provides expert technical advice and support to internal and external stakeholders on the management, dissemination and application of data sharing in a cross-government environment.
- Manages projects for system enhancements to data sharing platforms and supporting applications to meet customer and whole-of-government expectations.
- Undertakes complex systems and data analysis activities to support the availability of stable data sharing and collaboration platforms.
- Leads the design, scheduling and coordination of processes that support collaboration platforms, such as the Shared Location Information Platform (SLIP) and Data WA, including the management of support arrangements with other Landgate business units, third party suppliers and stakeholders.
- Leads the design, implementation and monitoring of processes to automate data transformation supporting data publishing to online platforms including SLIP and Data WA.
- Provides oversight of quality and completeness of metadata provided by custodians to support an effective whole-of-government data sharing environment.
- Works with third party providers to develop forward plans and contribute to the technology roadmap to support the evolution of data sharing and collaboration platforms, including SLIP and Data WA.

- Interprets technical system design and architecture documents provided by third party providers with a business and customer perspective.
- Oversees the preparation and delivery of business unit reporting for internal and external stakeholders, including KPI reporting, usage reports and security auditing.
- Builds and fosters operational relationships with user groups and stakeholders (including the Walis Community) to understand their current and future needs.
- Maintains an expert-level of awareness of new developments and trends to recommend improvements across the areas of data sharing, use of location information and technologies, and open data systems and practices, that will improve outcomes for customers and stakeholders.
- Champions open data principles and promotes a collaborative culture of data sharing within government and simplified access to data.
- Supports the Manager Data Collaboration to determine work programs; allocate resources and assess technical performance of team members.
- Adheres to Work Health and Safety (WHS) policies and procedures that ensures the safety of staff and customers.
- Acts with integrity at all times, demonstrates behaviours aligned with Landgate's code of ethics and works within relevant policies and procedures, contributing to the accountabilities of the team.
- Performs other duties as directed.

- Demonstrated experience building team capability through mentoring and coaching, fostering team development and continuous improvement.
- High level interpersonal skills with the ability to build collaborative relationships and engage effectively with diverse stakeholders to achieve outcomes
