Traffic Operations & Network Optimisation

Work hands on with the traffic control systems that manage over 1000+ traffic signals across WA, as well as thousands of Intelligent Transport System (ITS) devices – including Perth's expanding Smart Freeways network. Optimise the performance of the network through data driven decision making, see the results in real-time, and play a vital role in keeping people and freight moving. See how major events and disruptions are managed on Perth's transport network, in a live control room environment.

Traffic Engineering & Design

Provide specialist technical advice into road and intersection designs, major infrastructure projects and developments applications. Identify and investigate road upgrade projects that improve the journeys and safety of all road users.

Data Analytics & Artificial Intelligence

Work with our in-house big data systems and AI resources to develop new tools that identify performance gaps, and drive improvements to the road network.

Traffic Modelling & Visualisation

Gain training and valuable experience in the use of microanalytical and microsimulation modelling software. Evaluate the performance of major road upgrades to ensure the best outcomes for all road users and visualise the end product.
