Estimating

- Maintain estimating databases, including resource databases, unit rate databases, benchmarking databases etc.
- Assist in the measurement of item quantities for estimates in accordance with Main Roads Standard Method of Measurement (SMM)
- Assist in the pricing of estimate items using first principle methodology where practical.
- Review minor estimates procured through the Estimating & Commercial Services panel contract.
- Assist in the development and updating of estimating templates and guidance notes.

Contract Administration

- Assist in the assessment of contractor rise and fall claims
- Assist in the setting up of contract payment templates
- Manage the procurement of minor estimates through the estimating panel contract

Consult and liaise with our stakeholders (e.g. customers, the community, and contractors) on the development and delivery of projects and contracts.
