### KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

Manage Real Time Traffic Operations and associated services across the Metropolitan road network to ensure that the road network is operating at its maximum efficiency at all times in order to meet journey time and reliability targets.

## **Traffic Operations**

- Utilise traffic and transport management techniques and appropriate management tools to manage and continuously improve traffic performance across the Metropolitan road network.
- Coordinate the management of unplanned incidents and minimise their impact on the road network through the
  identification of incident risk, early detection, use of appropriate responses and incident plans, timely clearing and
  evaluation of outcomes.
- Monitor operational dashboards and real-time traffic data and report on the performance of the Real Time Traffic
   Operations team to meet network operational targets.
- Strategically resource Real Time Traffic Operations to ensure the presence of appropriately trained operators for 24/7 coverage.
- Manage services to remove illegally parked vehicles from Clearways, Bus Lanes and No Stopping Zones in the Perth Central Business District (CBD).
- Lead daily "lessons learnt" exercises to inform continuous improvement operations

### **Policy, Guidelines and Technical Standards**

 Manage the development, review and implementation of policy and guidelines related to traffic operations processes and practices and incident management response practices.

### **Leadership and Management**

- Model good leadership to inspire direction and performance, develop people, and drive change.
- Establish the principles, operating parameters and standards for traffic operations and foster the development of staff to
  provide best practice in the application of systems and traffic operations techniques to ensure that the team remain in a state
  of operational readiness.
- Manage financial, technological, physical and other resources within agreed allocations to meet agreed outcomes.
- Manage and promote the adherence to Safety, Health and Wellbeing.

### **Stakeholder Relationships**

- Build and enhance professional working relationships with Area and Route Managers and other key stakeholders.
- Represent Main Roads on committees and working parties, public meetings and workshops.
- Participation in Directorate strategic business and operational improvement initiatives.
