## **Job description**

#### **Overview of role**

You will undertake in-house and on the job training to carry out routine inspections and issue written notices while working in a team of inspectors undertaking the enforcement of OSH legislation.

You will also be responsible for building your capacity to take on more senior roles.

### Key responsibilities

As part of a team and with guidance:

- Carry out workplace inspections and take enforcement action when health and safety laws are breached;
- Investigate less complex or sensitive workplace incidents and accidents;
- Assist in gathering evidence and making recommendations about prosecutions;
- Promote OSH and provide information to workplaces;
- Liaise with client groups including employers, employees, government, unions and industry organisations;
- Participate in team projects and have input to future policy/direction;
- Contribute to sustaining a positive team culture; and
- Undertake other duties as directed that fall within the scope of the position.

Inspector development

• Continue your professional development through a variety of opportunities while gaining further

experience on the job.

• Complete mandatory tasks of the career progression system, to progress through to Level 5.

Other

• Take reasonable care to protect your own safety and health at work, and that of others by cooperating with the safety and health policies and procedures of the department and complying with all provisions of the *Occupational Safety and Health Act 1984*.
