Brief Summary of Duties

1. Clinical

- Maintains a caseload of clients. Provides a comprehensive and flexible community based clinical service to clients in accordance with the principles and processes of the MST Programme.
- Provides services to the Aboriginal Community and to other members of the MST Team in regard to Aboriginal clients.
- Provides services to clients on a need basis including out of hours in accordance with approved policies.
- Conducts community based MST assessment of clients.
- Implements complex problem conceptualisation, treatment, planning, intervention, outcome and strategy review for clients.
- Engages primary caregiver and other key participants in active change orientated treatment by identifying and overcoming barriers to engagement.
- Supervises and is responsible for interventions by relevant health professionals with other agencies and ensures cooperation throughout MST treatment.
- Accountable in conjunction with the Clinical Manager MST for client outcomes within the Service.
- Participates in weekly group supervision for MST Team to assure adherence to MST principles and the MST analytic process.
- Participates in individual supervision as needed to manage competency needs and to remove individual barriers to effective implementation of MST treatment.
- Ensures the production of comprehensive, Multisystemic management plans for all clients of the MST Unit.

2. Educational (Occasionally)

- Identifies in conjunction with the Clinical Manager MST any required training or development to assure a high level of competency in implementation of MST interventions.
- Participates in all MST Training, Supervision and consultation activities.

3. CAHS Governance, Safety and Quality Requirements

- Takes reasonable care for own health and safety and that of others and participates in the maintenance of a safe work environment.
- Participates in the Child and Adolescent Health Service (CAHS) performance development review process.
- Supports the delivery of safe patient care and the consumers' experience ensuring services
 are family centred. This includes participation in continuous quality improvement activities in
