### Key Responsibilities

Provide diagnostic imaging services to patients referred to the Medical Imaging Department at Perth Children's Hospital, and to patients at King Edward Memorial Hospital under the terms of any existing service level agreement (SLA).

## Brief Summary of Duties

### 1. Clinical

- To perform diagnostic imaging examinations and procedures on neonates and children referred to the Medical Imaging Department at PCH and to patients at KEMH under the terms of any existing SLA.
- To provide a written report for each examination performed.
- Provision of direct information and/or advice to referring medical practitioners.
- To participate in clinico-radiology meetings at the direction of the Head of Department at PCH when required.
- To participate in the after-hours emergency roster for the provision of diagnostic imaging services by the Department of Medical Imaging.

### 2. Teaching

- To be involved in teaching activities within the Department of Medical MIT.

### 3. Research

- To be actively involved in research programmes.
