KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

Manage the development, implementation and monitor plans, programs and systems for the efficient and effective management preservation and improvement of the road asset.

KEY DELIVERIES

Asset Management

- Manage, assess and report on road network performance against agreed levels of service, intervention, standards, environmental and product standards.
- Manage the identification of gaps and deficiencies and develop solutions and priorities to optimise the performance of the road network consistent with agreed levels of service, intervention, standards, environmental and product standards.
- Review and comment on maintenance delivery plans to ensure compliance with required levels of service and to ensure co-ordination of improvement and preservation activities.
- Manage the corporate road asset inventory to ensure that it accurately reflects the regional asset.
- Review and evaluate the effectiveness of implemented options towards addressing the solution to the identified gaps and deficiencies on the network.
- Contribute to the development, maintenance and improvement of asset planning, management processes and systems.
- Provide expert advice into the development and preparation of Ten Year Network Delivery Plan and Annual Metropolitan Works Program.

Asset Management Planning

- Develop and implement asset management models to the regional road network to support asset planning decision making.
- Manage the development of project concepts and preparation of project charters for improvement projects to address identified gaps and deficiencies.
- Manage the development and maintenance of the Regional Road and Network Plan and Asset Link Plans.
- Plan and program local and network expansion and improvement projects arising out of regional development activities.
- Facilitate the inclusions and deletions of the network as a result of approved Road Classifications changes into the region's asset management planning activities.

Contract Management

- Commission and manage consultants for the provision of technical services.

Leadership and Management

- Manage financial, technological, physical and other resources within agreed allocations to meet agreed outcomes.
- Manage employee behaviour, performance and development.
- Contribute to the development, management and implementation of Region's Business Plan.

Stakeholder Relationships

- Undertake consultation and liaison with key stakeholders (e.g. customers, the community, other agencies and Local Government) on road asset management plans, programs and interventions.
- Provide expert customer advice and prepare responses to ministerial enquiries, media contacts and community issues.
- Undertake negotiation, preparation, implementation and review of Memorandum of Understanding and Maintenance Agreements with Local Government Agencies and other stakeholders.

SAFETY, HEALTH AND WELLBEING (SHW)

Responsible for active participation and performance to SHW standards as detailed by the Main Roads' Safety, Health and Wellbeing (SHW) Management System - refer to "SHW Roles and Responsibilities Procedure" on 'iRoads' intranet.

LOCATION

Main Roads is a regionalised organisation with key delivery centres operating from the Kimberley to the Great Southern regions, including the metropolitan area. The incumbent of this position may be required to undertake a role in a region for a period of time.






