CONTEXT AND SCOPE

The Forest Products Commission is a Statutory Authority that manages the Government's forest industry resources in relation to sustainable forest management, contract harvesting and sale of forest products. The Forest Products Commission operates as a commercial business entity but also provides advice to and develops policy for government on issues relating to forest management, products and services.

ROLE

The role plans, implements and regulates allocated FPC harvesting, and transport operations as required. The role includes directing the protection and improvement of forest, woodland and rangeland resources. Although focused on the supervision of sandalwood production operations, this role may work throughout the State's commercial forest, plantation, woodland and rangeland harvesting operations. This position will also work with planning, inventory and silvicultural sections to meet the Commission's strategic objectives.

The position is responsible for the provision of information and facilities to the public including the provision of specialist information and will liaise with public authorities, public interest groups, Department of Biodiversity, Conservations and Attractions and external organisations.

As a member of the FPC team the position assists in the administration of Production Division activities and provides advice to the Manager on policy and operational matters. The position is required to implement programmes identified by the Forest Products Commission and monitors and controls operational budgets and costs.

The incumbent has responsibility for directing and controlling personnel, appraising performance and ensuring the implementation of adequate training and safety programs within the respective area.

Compliant with the Australian Forest Stanard and Environmental Management System as applicable, the position undertakes activities associated with monitoring and investigation and implementation of corrective and preventative action in response to environmental incidents.

- 1. Utilisation of the States forests, plantation, woodland and rangeland resources are optimised.
- 2. Forest Products Commission harvesting operations are planned and implemented.
- 3. Forest Products Commission operations are effectively and efficiently controlled.
