### Prime Function / Key Responsibilities

Provides a specialist Physiotherapy service in the Women's, Men's and Pelvic Health outpatient setting.

**Brief Summary of Duties (in order of importance)**

**1. Clinical Responsibilities**

- 1.1 Provides specialist Physiotherapy services in the Women's, Men's and Pelvic Health area through comprehensive patient screening and assessment, intervention and case management using advanced clinical practice and interdisciplinary skills.
- 1.2 Advises, consults and liaises with other professional staff, hospital and community agencies on clinical matters relating to case management in the area of specialty
- 1.3 Supervises students in approved clinical teaching and fieldwork programs as required.
- 1.4 Maintains patient records, including preparation of progress and final reports and maintains treatment statistics and related documentation.
- 1.5 Maintains close clinical liaison with the Musculo-Outpatient Physiotherapy Team
- 1.6 Participates in a weekend inpatient roster as requested.

**2. Professional Development Training**

- 2.1 Assists in the planning and provision of ongoing professional development for physiotherapists and other health professionals.
- 1.1 Undertakes continuing professional development to advance professional standards and specialist skills in the Breast cancer and Continence setting, including training in interdisciplinary interventions relevant to the area.

**3. Representation**

- 3.1 Participates in all relevant clinical management meetings with respect to Women's, Men's and Pelvic Health practice change and policy development.
- 3.2 Participates in ward rounds, case conferences, team and department meetings as required.

**4. NMHS Governance, Safety and Quality Requirements**

- 4.1 Participates in the maintenance of a safe work environment.
- 4.2 Participates in an annual performance development review.
- 4.3 Supports the delivery of safe patient care and the consumers' experience including participation in continuous quality improvement activities in accordance with the requirements of the National Safety and Quality Health Service Standards and other recognised health standards.
- 4.4 Completes mandatory training (including safety and quality training) as relevant to role.
- 4.5 Performs duties in accordance with Government, WA Health, North Metropolitan Health Service and Departmental / Program specific policies and procedures.

1. Tertiary qualifications in Physiotherapy and eligible for registration by the Physiotherapy Board of Australia.
2. Extensive clinical experience, knowledge and demonstrated clinical competence in the physiotherapeutic management of patients in the Women's, Men's and Pelvic Health field. This includes but not limited to adult patients pre and post prostatectomy, persistent pelvic pain, sexual dysfunction, bladder and bowel dysfunction and pelvic organ prolapse.
3. Demonstrated ability to work effectively within a multi-disciplinary and interdisciplinary team.
4. Demonstrated high level of interpersonal, verbal and written communication skills.
5. Demonstrated planning and organisational ability.
6. Experience in initiating and coordinating quality improvement and/or research activities.
7. Demonstrated commitment to, and involvement in ongoing professional development.
8. Knowledge of occupational safety and health principles including maintaining a Duty of Care.
9. Proven ability to supervise and conduct in-service training to staff and students.
