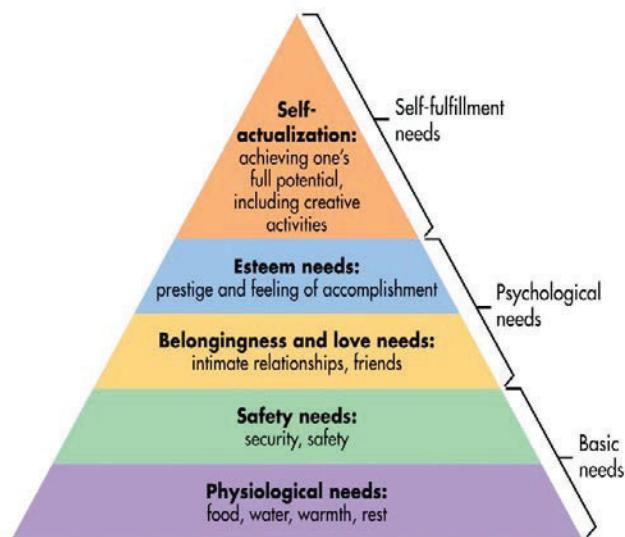


## We Believe ...

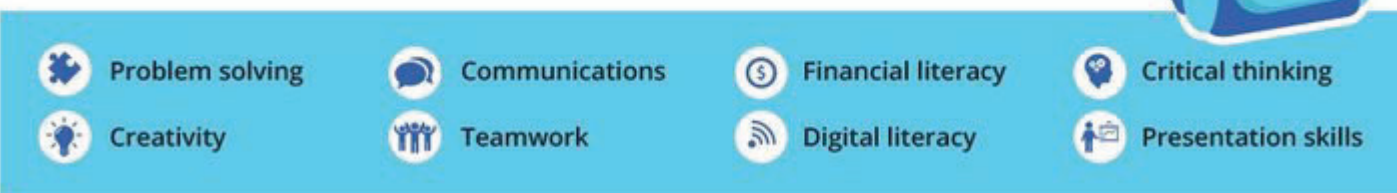


Maslow's Hierarchy of needs
