

- 4. Demonstrated ability to achieve outcomes for effective service delivery consistent with service needs and defined expectations.
- 5. Demonstrated expert level of organisational, negotiation and liaison skills, with an ability to work with complex team structures.
- 6. Demonstrated expert standard of written and verbal communication skills.
- 7. Demonstrated advanced and successful leadership and management experience, including skills in human resource and financial management, strategic planning, clinical governance and the maintenance and evaluation of professional standards.
- 8. Demonstrated advanced ability to prepare and present expert level of business reports and scientific reports.
- Demonstrated expert level of conceptual, analytical and problem solving skills, with a proven ability to
 provide collaborative and consultative solutions to complex issues of service delivery in
 multidisciplinary specialisations.
- 10. Demonstrated applied knowledge of legislative obligations for Occupational Safety and Health,
 Disability Services and Equal Opportunity, and how these impact on employment and service delivery.
