

Quick reference to the recruitment process and employment opportunities

What will I be required to do to apply and be selected?

(Please see the document 'Application Information Pack' which contains further details)

You will be required to undertake / submit / participate in the following -

1.	Written application and CV
2.	On-line psychological profiling and cognitive assessments.
3.	First round interview.
Note: Applicants that are shortlisted for the remaining stages are required to attend in person (in the Perth metropolitan area) and are responsible for covering any travel and accommodation costs that are incurred;	
5.	Behavioural interview
6.	Medical, fitness and swim assessments (further details of what will be assessed are in the Applicant Information Pack)
7.	Assessment centre which will include practical exercises, job simulations and role-plays
8.	References checks.

What opportunities are there for me and in what locations?

Following the recruitment process, selected individuals will be appointed as below -

1.	4 month fixed term contract to attend a training course – based in Fremantle
2.	Permanent appointment on successful completion of course – location of placements will be determined at this point in time, but could be in any of the four regions throughout the state.
