- Builds and maintains strong working relationships with stakeholders and represents the Department in inter-agency committees, taskforces and government and nongovernment bodies at State and National level.
- Works collaboratively with Managers across the Directorate and Pillars, other Government departments and relevant private sector stakeholders to implement strategic initiatives and to inform, influence and leverage the Department's or whole of government approach where appropriate.
- Provides policy advice and support to inter-departmental committees, peak industry groups and National committees to facilitate the achievement of government objectives.
