### KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

Ensure access to Information and Telecommunication Technology (ICT) managed systems across Main Roads is authorised, registered and controlled to prevent accidental or malicious damage to data and ICT infrastructure. Ensure security standards, policies and all current practical security measures are implemented, tested and are kept current and fully documented.

### KEY DELIVERIES

#### ICT Infrastructure Security

- Review performance and availability of Main Roads' ICT Security Systems and services.
- Identify problem and risk areas, design, propose and implement solutions to enhance ICT security systems and services.
- Research security trends relating to the provision of ICT Services, assess for relevance to Main Roads' operating environment and recommend suitable strategies and mitigations for infiltration security vulnerabilities and security incidents for ICT architecture.
- Initiate and manage projects designed to prepare Main Roads for responses to ICT security breaches, trends and to protect Main Roads' computer facilities, data resources and assets.
- Provide specialist advice on the management of anti-virus updates, agents and software on Main Roads' ICT network.
- Provide specialist advice on the management of security patches across all ICT infrastructure on Main Roads' network.
- Provide oversight to security reporting including internet usage and excessive or inappropriate use and co-ordinate auditing activities across Main Roads.
- Perform specialist investigations of security breaches and report on outcomes.
- Define, design and/or develop security standards and controls across a variety of technology stacks including networks, operating systems, databases and websites.
- Develop and review policies, procedures and standards for ICT security and manage their implementation to protect Main Roads' ICT infrastructure.

#### Leadership and Management

- Contribute to the formulation of the Branch's policy and strategy.
- Provide leadership in ICT security awareness to Main Roads' staff.
- Manage financial, technological, physical and other resources within agreed allocations to meet agreed outcomes.
- Manage employee behaviour, performance and development.

#### Stakeholder Relationships

- Build and maintain professional working relationships with internal staff and external stakeholders.
- Represent Main Roads and the Branch on working parties and forums relating to organisational ICT security.

### SAFETY, HEALTH AND WELLBEING (SHW)
