- Ensure structures asset management strategies are kept in line with National and State transport strategies, standards
  and other relevant requirements.

#### Structures Asset Management Systems and Capability

- Provide expert advice to external and internal audits and assessments of structures components of the Asset Management System (AMS).
- Provide expert advice on the development and management of structures management systems related to improvements in the corporate AMS.
- Provide expert advice on the development and management of Bridge Management System (BMS) and other structures AMS, tools and processes.
- Lead and promote the use of Austroads guidelines in asset management of structures.
- Provide expert advice and contribute to the development of capability (people and process) in structures asset
  management, including review of regional structures asset management practice, treatment selection and mentoring of
  practitioners.

#### Leadership and Management

- Contribute to the formulation and delivery of Branch Business Plans.
- Manage financial, technological, physical and other resources within agreed allocations to meet agreed outcomes.
- Manage employee behaviour, performance and development.
- Lead and manage individuals and teams to achieve agreed outcomes.

- Consult with internal and external stakeholders to facilitate adoption of 'best practice' structures asset management.
- Professionally collaborate with internal and external stakeholders to develop structures management strategies.
- Collaborate with regions to ensure input and consistency across the state in various strategies, structures maintenance needs and budgets.
- Collaborate with Structures Engineering Branch (SEB), Budget & Programming (B&P), Program Management Office (PMO) and regional structures asset managers in the adopting of structures asset strategies.
- Represent Main Roads on relevant committees and at appropriate forums.
