An exciting opportunity exists for a skilled and enthusiastic Consultant Surgeon – General Surgery. The successful applicant will provide surgical services to clients and patients attending WACHS-Kimberley. This includes provision of a visiting surgical service to Broome as well as other Kimberley sites. Services include surgical consultations, operating, post-operative care and participation in multidisciplinary care of patients. Teaching and supervision of junior medical staff is required.

The position is to provide surgical services to clients and patients, this includes provision of a visiting surgical service. Services include surgical consultations, operating, post-operative care and participation in multidisciplinary care of patients. You will be required to spend nights away from home on a regular basis, a shared on call commitment is expected of the successful applicant, along with short periods of outreach within the region, on a regular basis. Experienced in surgical management of trauma. You should also have highly developed communication, interpersonal, teamwork, negotiation and conflict resolution skills and a demonstrated commitment to teaching and research. Experience in basic Orthopaedics with an understanding of cross cultural Indigenous health issues is desirable.

Case mix, including acuity and activity is highly varied, with 25 000 presentations per year to the Emergency Department. Facilities include operating theatres, consulting rooms for visiting specialists, a public dental surgery, refurbished maternity unit and an expanded emergency department which has more than doubled in size to 15 acute bays. Broome is famous for its beach lifestyle and is recognised as a tropical tourist destination of choice. It has excellent schooling and housing choices.

The Kimberley is Western Australia's most northern region, with the Broome coastline closer to South-East Asia than it is to Perth. Bordered by the Pilbara region to the south and Northern Territory to the east, the 424,517 square kilometres region has fewer people per square kilometre than almost any other place on Earth.
