Prime Function / Key Responsibilities

Consults, assesses, diagnoses and treats referred clients as part of specialist youth mental health service, Hospital in The Home. Delivers specialist psychiatric service to clients of Youth Hospital in the Home and their carers/families.

Brief Summary of Duties

1. Clinical and Professional Services

- 1.1 Provides expert medical and psychiatric assessment and management for adolescents and youth referred to and managed by Youth Hospital in the Home.
- 1.2 Provides specialist consultative support to other professionals within the Youth Hospital in the Home multidisciplinary team, Youth Mental Health and across the broader health system.
- 1.3 Where applicable, assess referred persons for assessment and treatment in accordance with the Mental Health Act (2014).
- 1.4 Collaborates and negotiates with public and private organisations regarding appropriate treatment services for clients, families and carers.
- 1.5 Ensures records, clinical documentation and statistics are kept in accordance with established procedures.
- 1.6 Ensures records and statistics (ie. NOCC) are kept in accordance with established procedures.

2. Research, Training, Development and Capacity Building

- 2.1 Participates in instruction of medical graduates, undergraduates and nursing and other staff and undertakes other lecturing as required.
- 2.2 Provides supervision of Trainee Psychiatrists' in accordance with RANZCP training program.
- 2.3 Initiates and participates in research as agreed with Director Youth Mental Health.

3. NMHS Governance, Safety and Quality Requirements

- 3.1 Participates in the maintenance of a safe work environment.
- 3.2 Participates in an annual performance development review.
- 3.3 Supports the delivery of safe patient care and the consumers' experience including participation in continuous quality improvement activities in accordance with the requirements of the National Safety and Quality Health Service Standards and other recognised health standards.
- 3.4 Completes mandatory training (including safety and quality training) as relevant to role.
- 3.5 Performs duties in accordance with Government, WA Health, North Metropolitan Health Service and Departmental / Program specific policies and procedures.

- 6. Current "C" or "C.A." class drivers licence.
- 7. Current knowledge of legislative obligations for Equal Opportunity, Disability Services and Occupational Safety and Health, and how these impact on employment and service delivery.
