### **Key responsibilities**

- Ensure high levels of quality control, storage and hygiene are maintained in accordance with occupational safety and health standards and requirements.
- Provide meals of a high standard, manage day-to-day catering requirements of the college and external groups and cater for special occasions and functions as required. This involves:
  - o preparation
  - $\circ$  cooking
  - o catering for special dietary requirements
  - stock control
  - o purchasing goods
- Work effectively with other cook/s and kitchen hand/s.

### Selection criteria

- 1. Demonstrated ability to carry out the duties of a cook, for 50 to 110 students, to a high standard, including catering for special dietary requirements.
- 2. Demonstrated ability to manage and control stock and uphold health and safety standards in relation to food and kitchen hygiene.
- 3. Demonstrated good organisational skills with the ability to work independently.
- 4. Demonstrated good interpersonal skills and the ability to relate to youth.
- 5. Demonstrated flexibility in response to changing work needs.



# Eligibility and training requirements

- complete the Department's induction program within three months of commencement
- complete any training specific to this role required by Departmental policy
