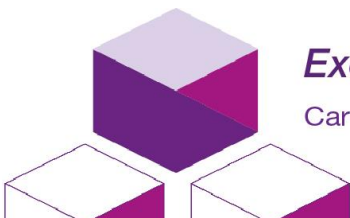

Brief Summary of Duties (in order of importance)

1. General

- 1.1 Attend to patients in a professional manner.
- 1.2 Attend to special room cleans as and when required.
- 1.3 Assist with the transfer of patients and equipment to designated areas.
- 1.4 Ensure that patient welfare, privacy and security is observed during procedures.
- 1.5 Maintain adequate stock levels in the Medical Imaging Department; pharmaceutical drugs for injection excluded.
- 1.6 Participate in shift work as required.

2. Medical Imaging Duties

- 2.1 Co-ordinate flow of patients to the Medical Imaging Department by liaising as necessary with the supervisors in the various imaging modalities.
- 2.2 Clean all imaging equipment and cleans MRI room in accordance with MRI safety standards.
- 2.3 Assist in preparation of patients for General, CT, Nuclear Medicine, Breast Imaging, Ultrasound and MRI examinations by changing patients into gowns, providing water for ultrasound patients, oral contrast for CT patients, intravenous cannulation and screening patients from MRI.
- 2.4 Assist the Radiologist with Ultrasound procedures.
- 2.5 Ensure documentation is completed prior to imaging procedures and radiological reporting.
- 2.6 Organise transport for patients to and from the wards.

3. SMHS Governance, Safety and Quality Requirements

- 3.1 Participates in the maintenance of a safe work environment.
- 3.2 Participates in an annual performance development review.
- 3.3 Supports the delivery of safe patient care and the consumers' experience including participation in continuous quality improvement activities in accordance with the requirements of the National Safety and Quality Health Service Standards and other recognised health standards.
- 3.4 Completes mandatory training (including safety and quality training) relevant to role.
- 3.5 Performs duties in accordance with Government, WA Health, South Metropolitan Health Service and Department / Program specific policies and procedures.
- 3.6 Abides by the WA Health Code of Conduct, Occupational Safety and Health legislation, the Disability Services Act and the Equal Opportunity Act.

4. Other Duties

- 4.1 Performs other duties as specified by the supervising MIT, Chief and Deputy Medical Imaging Technologist.
