

Registrar Service Paediatrics Albany Health Campus (Great Southern Region)

Six month or 12 month full time appointments (80 hours per fortnight)

The Great Southern Paediatric Service is the newest of the WACHS Paediatric services and will continue to develop and expand over the coming years.

This paediatric registrar position in Albany, therefore, will provide a unique opportunity to contribute to the development of a regional service. Paediatric inpatients and neonates from 37/40 at Albany Health Campus. Outpatients – separate medical and developmental paediatric clinics.

Approximately 2 days of developmental and 1.5 days of medical a week. Outreach to Katanning with potential for other outreach sites in the near future.

Four paediatric beds on mixed adult/paediatric ward. Neonatal nursery accreditation planned for 2023.

Application for accreditation with RACP for 6 months rural without perinatal component in progress. Once accredited, potential for 6 months community child health when appointed to 12 month position. Aiming to complete accreditation by second half of 2022.
