Responsibilities also include managing the delivery of key regional projects:

- Goldfields Highway (Sealing the Wiluna to Meekatharra section) \$20 million over the next four years;
- Great Eastern Highway (Upgrading Southern Cross to Coolgardie)- \$150 million over the next six years;
- Outback Way Sealing the Great Central Roads between Laverton and the WA/NT border - \$142 million over the next six years.

Working in the Goldfields Esperance region, you will gain invaluable experience managing projects in the vast and unique landscape. You will mentor and support staff to make best practice decisions for infrastructure projects in the Region. You will also collaborate with your team to improve future work delivery and play a key role in resourcing allocation for new projects.

Why the Goldfields-Esperance region?
