Key responsibilities

- Ensure all laundering tasks are performed and completed within the time allocated.
- Ensure laundry is sorted out into different categories for appropriate washing machine cycle.
- Ensure all washed, dried and pressed clothing items are neatly folded and returned to their respective storage areas.
- Clean up the laundry floor, washing machines and cupboards.
- Maintain a sufficient supply of laundry detergents and supplies.
- Assist in keeping all washing machines, irons and other electrical equipment in good working order.
- Make arrangements for students to recover unmarked clothing.
- Ensure occupational health and safety standards are maintained.

Selection criteria

- 1. Demonstrated ability to carry out the duties of a laundry hand to a high standard.
- 2. Demonstrated good interpersonal and organisational skills, including the ability to work effectively with youth and as part of a team.
- 3. Demonstrated ability to uphold appropriate health and safety standards.
- 4. Demonstrated flexibility in response to changing work needs.



Eligibility and training requirements

Employees will be required to:

- obtain a current Department of Education Criminal Record Clearance prior to commencement of employment
- obtain or hold a current Working with Children Check
- complete the Department's induction program within three months of commencement
- complete any training specific to this role required by Departmental policy
- complete the Department's training in Accountable and Ethical Decision-Making within six months of appointment.
