Maintains a high quality environment for patients, staff and all site users by carrying out plumbing and gas works and maintenance for all plant, equipment services.

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Brief Summary of Duties (in order of importance)

- Carries out fault finding, assembly, fitting, installation, maintenance and repair of NMHS assets relative to the trade and other competencies that may be claimed, assessed and recognised by the organisation.
- 2. Where appropriate costs and orders materials and processes Work Requests using the electronic online Asset Management System.
- 3. Implements quality control techniques including cleanliness and systemic methods which are essential in hospital maintenance.
- 4. Maintains tools and equipment in good working order and condition and ensures security of hospital property by taking due care in executing allocated tasks.
- 5. Carries out all duties in accordance with prescribed workmanship standards and complies with all OSH obligations and prescribed safety standards and best working practice.
- 6. Complies with NMHS policies, procedures, code of conduct and other legislation.
- 7. Participates in the staff development program including orientation, in-service, performance appraisal and quality activities.
- 8. Assists with Apprentice training as required.
- 9. Carries out other duties as directed.
