This is fostered through the extensive year 7 to year 12 secondary education program, supported by vocational education and training (VET), cultural, artistic and sporting opportunities. A key element of our academic STEM program is the centre of resources excellence (core), with the Pilbara core program offered to interested students in years 7 and 8.

The school is also participating in the Fogarty Foundation Edvance program, a whole school improvement program providing school executive teams with leadership and management skills via a mentorship to improve the educational outcomes of our students.
