- Co-ordinate the movement of vehicles in and out of depot.
- Initiate corrective actions as identified by the audit or any other mechanism.
- Provide support to Business Manager with annual review activities for the Depot Management Plan.
- Provide support in testing and implementing the Emergency Response Procedures.
- Report building related hazards and issues to the Business Manager for action.
- Provide support with arranging depot and office repairs, services and supply requirements.

## **Plant Administration**

- Maintain records in the Unifleet Plant Administration System.
- Generate reports from the Unifleet system, as required.
- Provide plant and equipment information and reports to the Maintenance Manager.

Build and maintain effective working relationships with contractors and other suppliers.
