The North Metropolitan Eating Disorders Specialist Service (NMEDSS) has been established to provide a range of community-based eating disorder treatment programs.

NMEDSS will offer a comprehensive day treatment program, a specialist multi-disciplinary outpatient service, intensive clinical monitoring and care transition coordination between services.

To ensure we are delivering evidence-based care at the right time and in the right place, our service is being developed to link closely with other service providers, primary health care providers and tertiary settings to maintain continuity of care.

NMEDSS is looking for a range of professionals who have a strong commitment to providing excellence in eating disorder treatment.

This is an opportunity to be involved in implementing and delivering a vital service. You will be part of a team of dedicated experts contributing to the state's first public health stepped-care eating disorder treatment.

Building a great team

This service will be a game changer in the treatment of eating disorders in WA. We are expanding our initial expert multidisciplinary team to develop and deliver a range of evidence-based eating disorders programs.

Over the coming months (now until April 2024), we will be recruiting a range of health clinicians with an interest in eating disorders to build a service that is person centred, holistic and life changing.

Our multidisciplinary team will be a mixture of fulltime and part-time clinicians, including:

- General medicine physician
- Consultant psychiatrist
- Clinical nurses
- Dietitian
- Senior social worker
- Clinical psychologist/Registrar
- · Senior exercise physiologist

We also offer relevant education, training and supervision for individuals and with the team.

In addition, we will support team members to become a Credentialed Eating Disorder Clinician (CEDC) with the Australia and New Zealand Academy of Eating Disorders/National Eating Disorders Collaboration.
