PURPOSE OF THE POSITION

The Senior Lighting Technician is responsible for the installation, operation, maintenance and removal of lighting production equipment. The Senior Lighting Technician will undertake a key role in the programming and operation of lighting consoles.

- 2. Programming and operation of lighting consoles.
- 3. Maintains, repairs and manages the organisation and storage of technical equipment and assets.

- 5. Other duties as required that fall within the parameters of the position.
