

# Fact sheet of incentives while working in the Pilbara

- subsidised GROH housing for eligible staff including Principals, Deputy Principals, Teachers, MCS and School Psychologists
  - no lock in contracts for GROH housing;
  - no rental bond;
  - option to pay rent pre-tax;
  - supply of boxes, packing, transport and delivery of household items and furniture;
  - transport of up to two vehicles or a boat, caravan or trailer in lieu of the second vehicle;
  - removal insurance during transit;
  - reimbursement of travel costs to appointment location (road or air);
  - excess baggage allowance for appointment travel;
  - accommodation and en route meals reimbursement while on appointment travel;
  - GROH furniture;
    - fridge/freezer
    - lounge suite
    - dining setting
    - outdoor setting
    - washing machine
  - annual travel concession, at the completion of each school year – travel to Perth and return (no accommodation or meals en route);
  - long term storage while residing in GROH accommodation;
  - depreciation allowance;
  - pet allowance;
  - disturbance allowance;
  - property allowance;
  - air conditioning subsidy; and
  - at the completion of the contract/or to new appointment same support is offered
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- Port Hedland is only a ‘hop, skip and a jump’ from major tourism spots like Broome, Karrajini National Park and numerous camping areas if you wish to explore the Pilbara.
