KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

Manage medium size, moderately complex transport infrastructure projects in accordance with approved scope, budget, time and quality. Provide specialist technical advice/input for managing transport infrastructure projects.

Note: depending on project status, this position may be required to, at different times:

- only manage projects
- only manage contracts
- manage both projects and contracts

KEY DELIVERIES

Project Management

- Develop project management plans in accordance with Main Roads' project management processes and procedures.
- Undertake project development activities including procurement of consultants as required.
- Manage project schedules, risks, contingency management and progress reporting.
- Manage project cost estimate, budgeting, cash-flow, finances and forecasting.
- Review designs and arrange for specialist design review as required.
- Manage pre-construction activities.
- Undertake project close-out including lessons learned and reporting.

Contract Management

- Prepare procurement and contract documentation.
- Manage procurement of construction contractors, third party and specialist consultants and contract resources.
- Undertake contract management duties as delegated under the contract.
- Ensure compliance with contract requirements.
- Contribute towards improving safety in the workplace and monitor contractor's safety performance.
- Monitor progress, maintain records and prepare reports.
- Assess and recommend on claims and variations and arrange appropriate approvals.
- Review and report on contractor performance.
- Undertake contract close-out including handover and reporting.

Leadership and Management

- Manage project teams, contract management teams and other resources.
- Manage financial, technological, physical and other resources within agreed allocation to meet agreed outcomes.
- Manage employee behaviour, performance and development.
- Contribute towards the development and improvement of project management and contract management processes and systems.

Stakeholder Relationships

- Manage complex and sensitive consultations and negotiations with diverse stakeholders and the community, within agreed timeframes given their varying expectations and interests, in relation to the development and delivery of projects and contracts.
- Manage interfaces within the agency and across portfolio.

SAFETY, HEALTH AND WELLBEING (SHW)


