KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

Develop, maintain and improve the Integrity Data Analytics Governance Framework (IDAGF) including data security, access, reporting, and internal and external roles and responsibilities. Develop Data Analytics in line with the Integrity Detection Improvement Plan (IDIP) and in collaboration with the business areas across Main Roads. Develop, implement and review integrity analytics for data driven decisions in business areas and monitor performance.

KEY DELIVERIES

Integrity Analytics Framework

- Develop, maintain and improve IDAGF including data security, access, reporting and allocate internal and external roles and responsibilities within the Framework.
- Business partner and consult with business areas to assess and improve detection analytics and objectives.
- Project manage the yearly development and review of data analytics, including testing, workshops, budget, internal
 and external stakeholders and project resources including external contractors.
- Develop/review IDIP for each year, which considers new and improved detection analytics based on a business area's risk profile and in collaboration with the business area.
- Review and implement operational improvements to relevant policy and procedures.
- Undertake research as to what is suitable contemporary 'best practice' regarding detection and controls.

Integrity Data Analytics

- Develop data analytics as per the IDIP in partnership with Main Roads' business areas.
- Develop detailed data analytics design formulas and programming logic for chosen detection activities.
- Program and review 3rd party programming of Data Analytics (T-SQL, Power BI, DAX, VBA, Visual Studio/SSIS).
- Co-ordinate the implementation of new/revised analytics in business areas and monitor performance.
- Perform data search using relevant programming languages, analyse 'documentary evidence' and deliver insights in the form of infographics and visualisations for data driven management decisions.
- Review and implement innovative procedures and solutions that support and improve the efficiency and management
 of the Integrity analytics within Main Roads.

Stakeholder Relationships

- Build and enhance collaborative working relationships with Executive Directors, Directors and Branch Managers to support their knowledge and understanding of Integrity processes and compliance matters.
- Build and enhance professional working relationships with external agencies, particularly within the Transport
 portfolio, Minister's Office, State Solicitor's Office and central Government agencies.
