Where will the On-Road Incident Response Crew Officer take you?

Our crew provide rapid response to incidents on the metropolitan road network patrolling and mitigating hazards that impede traffic flow. As a On-Road Incident Response Crew Officer, some of your duties will include:

- Patrol the road network and identify incidents and hazards that are unsafe.
- Work with your colleagues at Main Roads to implement contingency Traffic Management Plans.
- Assist in communicating changes in traffic conditions, route detours or delays to road users and other affected parties.
- Respond and assess incidents to identify immediate threats to people and property. Help protect road users and assist in resumption of normal traffic flow.
- Liaise with emergency and other relevant service provides for on-road incidents.
- Complete audits of supplies for our incident response vehicles to ensure they are ready for incident response projects.
- Be a person of trust and empathy to members of the community who are affected by road incidents/trauma.
 - Provide basic first aid before the arrival of emergency services and arrange relevant on-scene services.

This is a critical role that provides an invaluable service to our community.
