- Undertake project close-out including lessons learned and reporting.
- Leverage resources to maximise efficiencies and achieve required project and program outcomes.

Contract Management

- Prepare procurement and contract management documentation.
- Manage procurement of construction contractors, third party services and specialist consultants and contract resources.
- Conduct commercial and risk mitigation negotiations.
- Undertake contract management duties as delegated under the contract.
- Ensure compliance with contract management requirements.
- Contribute towards improving safety in the workplace and monitor contractor's safety performance.
- Monitor progress, maintain records and prepare reports.
- Assess and recommend on progress and variations claims and arrange appropriate approvals.
- Review and report on contractor performance.
- Undertake contract close-out including handover and reporting.

- Manage project teams, contract management teams and other resources.
- Manage financial, technological, physical and other resources within agreed allocations to meet agreed outcomes.
- Manage employee behaviour, performance and development.
- Contribute towards continuous improvement of project management and contract management capability.

Engagement of Customers and Stakeholders

- Manage complex and sensitive consultations and negotiations with diverse stakeholders and the community, within agreed timeframes given their varying expectations and interests in relation to the development and delivery of projects and contracts.
- Manage interfaces within the agency and across portfolio.
