STAGE 1

Our application process is live from 21 July to 4 August 2025 (8am AWST). You can use the link on the PTA Careers page to direct you to the advert. You will be required to upload your CV, a copy of your most recent academic transcripts for all relevant qualifications, and respond to a number of questions on the online application form.

STAGE 2

Subject to meeting the requirements set out within the advert, you will be invited to complete online testing in early August 2025. These tests are designed to measure a number of attributes to help assess your suitability for the role. Please note that the assessment must be completed online, through a compatible web browser (such as Edge, Safari, Chrome or Firefox).

STAGE 3

Upon successful completion of the assessments and if shortlisted to progress to the next stage, you will get the chance to learn more about the PTA's program and have the opportunity to meet your potential manager and graduate coordinator at an interview in September 2025. Reference checks will also be conducted following interviews.

STAGE 4

Emails will be sent to all applicants notifying them of the outcome of the process in early October 2025.

STAGE 5

Offers are subject to pre-employment checks. This involves a medical assessment to verify physical fitness to perform the duties of the position (including colour vision and drug and alcohol testing) and provision of a national police clearance. These pre-employment checks will be undertaken in October 2025.

The Vacation Student program runs from 24 November 2025 to 13 February 2026. Students may be offered part-time undergraduate contract extensions to November 2026.
